The receipt of the PP had been delayed by Australian Customs (reason unknown) then by Turkish Customs (who slapped duty on them and refused to release them). But finally, the following acknowledgement of all the hard work was received:

This is part of the narrative from Asye, which accompanied the photos..."A part of our pocket pals were presented to earthquake survivor children who came together in a village in Hatay thanks to our Rotary mobile kindergarten (my precious GG project). Our volunteer teachers of the kindergarten happily shared below pics with me, they all send their very sincere greetings and kisses to all of you... Also I told about this to our district governor who sent his very best regards to you as well. There will be more in the upcoming days... We will present some of them to the handicapped and disabled earthquake victim children living in container cities soon."

Attached are some photographs of the children receiving the Pocket Pals. I want to thank everybody who has helped in the production of the PPs, and the assistance in the delivery of same to Turkey. For Deborah it has been a labour of love although at times the 'labour' bit has proved very frustrating at times.

One of our returned Rotary Youth Leadership Award (RYLA) candidates Ivey Chedid dropped in to talk to us about her busy week. She described RYLA as exceptional and genuinely life changing. The amazing speakers that took time out of their busy lives to talk to them included **Channel TEN** newsreader, journalist and foreign correspondent **Hugh Riminton**, former South Sudanese child soldier now lawyer and refugee advocate, and **2017 NSW Australian of the Year Deng Adut**, MLA and dual **Paralympian** (basketball and sailing) **gold medallist Liesl Tesch AM, Shane Fitzsimmons AO AFSM** former **Head of Resilience NSW** and the **Commissioner of the NSW**

Rural Fire Service, former Detective Superintendent and "gangbuster" Deborah Wallace and Australian Army veteran Shane Healey.



Ivey found Deborah Wallace's talk especially helpful as Deb was a woman in a mainly male environment in the NSW Police Force and Ivey is studying mechanical engineering where her cohort is roughly 90 per cent male. As well as speakers, RYLA provided a range of activities, including in crisis management. Meeting **70 young adults** with similar aims and leadership focus has given her a range of contacts in many fields – RYLArians are great at keeping in touch.

Ivey is **President** of the **Northern Beaches Rotaract Club** so will use her new skills in reinvigorating the group, with several fellow RYLArians planning to join.


